

2008 Grant Application Guidelines

MCA will provide up to but not exceeding \$10,000.

MCA will fund youth-oriented programs that pro-actively address the needs of middle and high school age youth at risk or potentially at risk.

MCA **does not fund** administrative costs, salaries, and/or independent contractor's fees.

The application must include the following information:

1. Name of Organization, Address, and Telephone Number
2. Date of Incorporation
3. Name of Director and Professional Staff Members
4. Proof of Tax-Exempt Status
5. The most recent Financial Statement and Budget for this Fiscal Year
6. An in-depth description of the specific project to be funded with a detailed budget breakdown of the costs of the project
7. The approximate number and age of youth to be served by this program.
8. Statement regarding whether the project is new or on-going
9. The amount requested for this specific program
10. Other funding received and/or anticipated future funding
11. List of any fees or revenues received from program participants
- 12. All** Grantees must submit a follow-up Progress Report to MCA by June 30 of the year the agency receives funding. The report will include a specific breakdown of how Grant funds were utilized.
