- ❖ **Since its founding, MCA has donated over \$2,000,000 to Marin-based, non-profit child welfare organizations**
- ❖ **We are a group of over 120 volunteer women dedicated to the needs of deserving Marin children. We have no paid staff.**
- ❖ **Fully 100% of all funds raised are distributed to the community every January. We have no overhead.**
